## **SHIFT NURSE** (CMO/2019/1/E)

**The Job:** The appointee will be required to conduct health prevention and screening activities on patients at NLNG clinic. He/she will ensure proper monitoring of health conditions of patients, and maintain maximum hospital hygiene.

The appointment will be for a 5-year period at the Plant location in Bonny. Upon expiration of the 5-year period, the possibility of a new contract exists, depending on business need and performance.

Duties include but are not limited to:

- Make tentative diagnoses, triage patients efficiently at accident site and administer life-saving treatment to casualty en-route the hospital, in order to alleviate adverse effect of trauma/ill-health.
- Implement nursing care plans for ill, injured, convalescent or disabled patients, following acceptable standards; provide immunization and health education services to all hospital clients.
- Operate medical equipment; administer treatment/ medication as indicated by patients' response and condition, and help with patient follow-up to facilitate patient rehabilitation.
